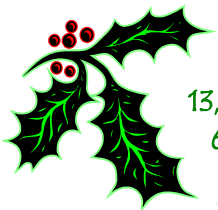


USM LA COLLEGE ADDITION

Maine Residents Property Tax and Rent Refund Program

YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR A REFUND IF:

- You do not have a spouse or dependent(s) and your 2005 household income was \$77,000.00 or less; or
- You have a spouse or dependent(s) and your 2005 household income was \$102,000.00 or less

AND

- Your 2005 property tax was more than 4% of your 2005 household income; or
- The rent you paid in 2005 was more than 20% of your 2005 household income

*Filing Deadline: Your Maine Residents Property Tax and Rent Refund Application must be filed by May 31, 2007.
